ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For entry into the Bachelor of Early Childhood Education (Birth to Five) you will need one of the following:

- Year 12 ATAR selection rank 60 or above.
- Other Australian Qualification (e.g. Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care and above).
- Overseas qualification (e.g. NCEA Level 3, the International Baccalaureate (IB) and GCE A Levels, plus other country-specific qualifications).

Additional admission requirements:

 Bachelor of Early Childhood Education students will also need to undertake additional admission requirements, including obtaining a Working with Vulnerable People Card.


ACADEMIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS
