




Extended master's programmes

London Metropolitan University extended master's programmes are designed to help international students to acquire, develop and demonstrate the skills required to successfully undertake postgraduate study in their chosen field.

Our extended master's programmes begin with a 15-week Pre-master's Programme (PMP) on the main campus of London Metropolitan University followed by a one-year full-time principal master's degree.



Pre-master's Programme

The Pre-master's Programme has been specifically designed to enhance international students' skills and knowledge of UK higher education in preparation for their chosen field of study at London Metropolitan University. More specifically, the Pre-master's Programme will help you to:

- develop knowledge of your chosen subject area and prepare for postgraduate study in the UK
- identify and develop research skills to support your study at master's level
- improve your self-management and personal awareness qualities needed by independent and reflective learners
- develop the ability to apply critical thinking skills to the understanding of unfamiliar environments

After completing the PMP, international students will join the master's programme in their preferred area of study at London Metropolitan University.

Subject to meeting academic progression requirements for the principal course, students can progress to the below list.

Master of Business Administration Extended Master's MBA

Develop your understanding of business operations and the external factors affecting organisations, as well as how to navigate business decisions in a changing environment.

International Business Management Extended Master's MSc

Gain an in-depth understanding of global business organisations, the environments in which they operate and how they create value sustainably.

International Business Management with Project Management Extended Master's MSc

Develop an in-depth understanding of business organisations, their external environment and how they create value sustainably, with a particular focus on the area of project management.

International Relations Extended Master's MA

Gain knowledge and skills that will equip you for analytical research on contemporary structures, processes and factors in international relations.

Data Analytics Extended Master's MSc

Dive into vital subjects including data mining, statistical modelling, business intelligence and data visualisation.

Computer Networking and Cyber Security Extended Master's MSc

Gain an understanding of the principles underpinning effective approaches to cyber defence in response to a cyber-attack.

Public Health Extended Master's MSc

Learn about the fundamental factors when considering public health, from the viewpoint that public health policy is much wider than healthcare alone.

Education Extended Master's MA

You'll gain the knowledge and confidence to debate different subjects around philosophy, the history of education, curriculum theory, psychology and much more.

Entry requirements

Academic requirements

Successful evidence of educational achievement in the country of origin (either a higher diploma or an honours degree) and/or completion of an associate degree or bachelor's degree or equivalent.

Language

Academic IELTS - 5.5 overall (minimum 5.5 in each component) (two years validity - needs to be in date at time of visa application)

TOEFL - including special home edition - Reading 18, Listening 17, Speaking 20, Writing 17

Pearson PTE Academic - Overall score required 59 (minimum 59 in each component)

Language Cert - 33/50 (Component scores required 33/50) **WAEC SSCE -** C6
