Excited about moving to Australia to study? We're just as thrilled to welcome you!

We value the vibrant contribution that international students make to our campus, culture, and community. And with an international scholarship, you can focus on experiencing all that Swinburne and life in Sydney has to offer, while hopefully easing some financial constraints.

When you apply to commence an intake in an eligible course for the first time from June 2024 until December 2024 at Swinburne Sydney, we automatically consider you for the available international scholarship based on the grades of your previous study. If your application for study is successful, you will receive a letter of offer from us. In that same letter of offer, you will be notified if you have received an international scholarship. Unsuccessful applicants will not be notified.

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for an international scholarship, you must:

- be an international student (citizens of Australia or New Zealand and permanent residents of Australia are not eligible)
- meet any course or scholarship-specific entry requirements
- not be in receipt of a Swinburne tuition fee scholarship or reduced fee arrangement at any one time (Swinburne will apply the most favourable arrangement to your enrolment)
- not be in receipt of another form of tuition fee scholarship or reduced fee arrangement from another organisation at the same time.
