

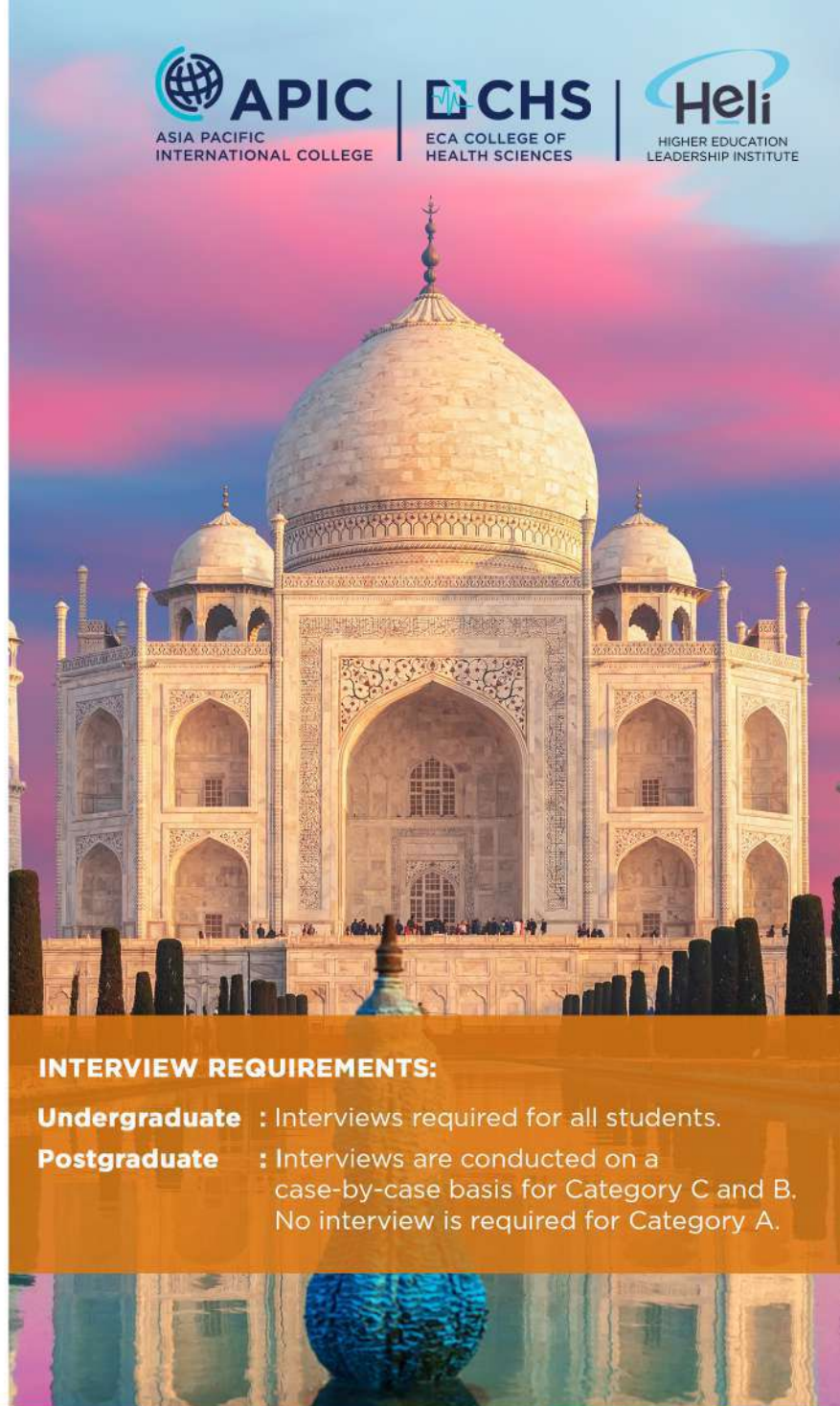
GS RULES ADMISSION AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INDIA

GS Rules Overview

Regional Classifications

Category	Region	Requirement
A (Low Risk Level)	Rest of India	50% of first-year fees must be deposited.
B (Medium Risk Level)	Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Hyderabad, Uttar Pradesh	75% of first-year fees must be deposited.
C (High Risk Level)	Punjab, Haryana, Gujarat, Rajasthan (Sri Ganganagar), and Jammu & Kashmir	100% of first-year fees must be deposited.

INTERVIEW REQUIREMENTS:

Undergraduate : Interviews required for all students.

Postgraduate : Interviews are conducted on a case-by-case basis for Category C and B. No interview is required for Category A.

Key Points:

- Regional classifications determine deposit amounts and interview requirements.
- Category C regions require full fee deposits for the first-year fees, Category B requires 75%, and Category A requires 50%.
- Postgraduate applicants may need to submit loans, or other financial proofs based on their scenario and region category.
- Each scenario offers clear guidelines depending on student profiles, covering loans, cash payments, and necessary financial documentation for each region category.
