This programme builds essential skills, including English language proficiency and a thorough understanding of UK educational standards and higher education academic expectations.

Students will focus on study skills, writing conventions and independent learning techniques while developing foundational knowledge in their subject area. This programme also emphasises refining academic writing and research skills, ensuring that students are well-prepared for undergraduate studies and can thrive in their chosen fields.

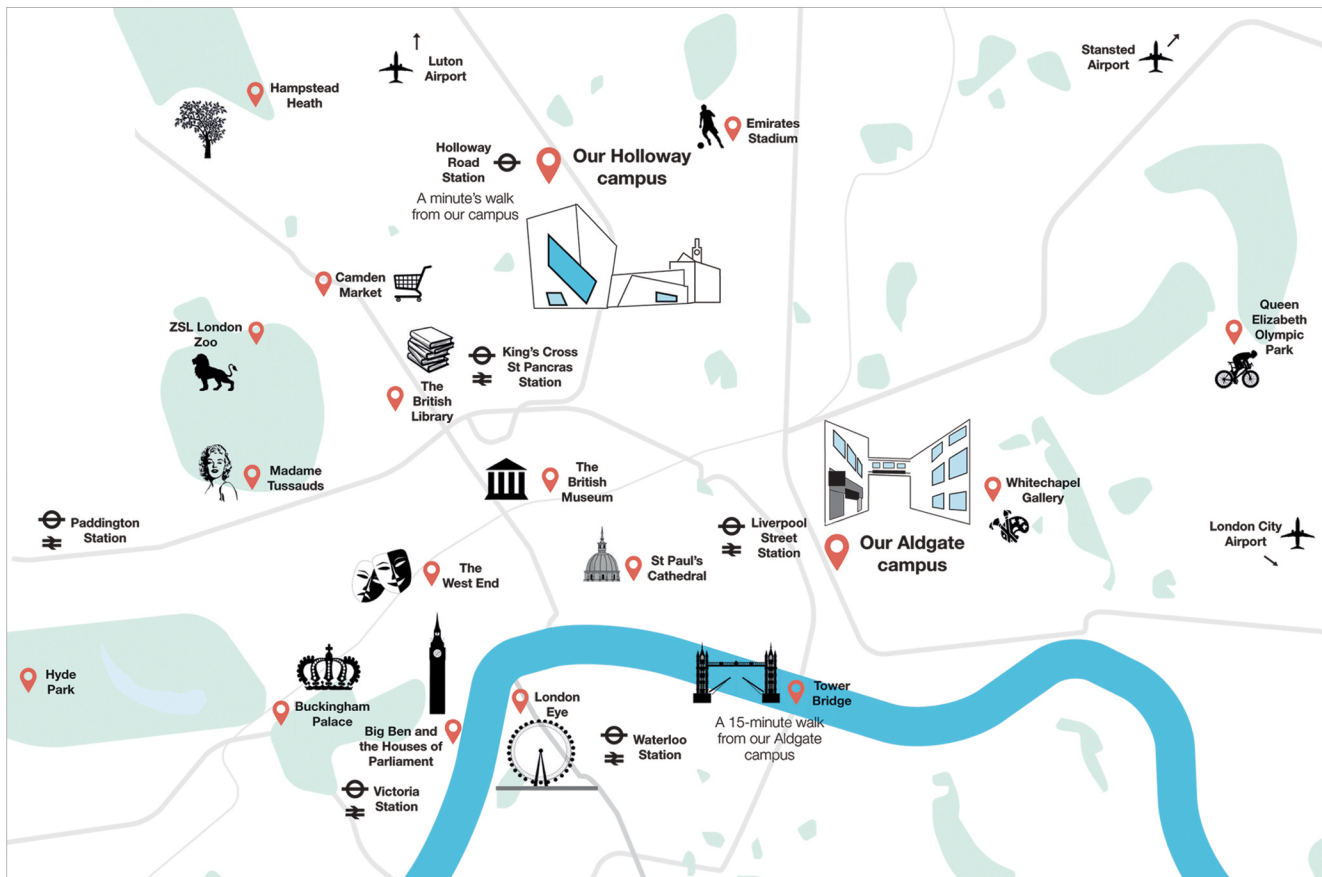
