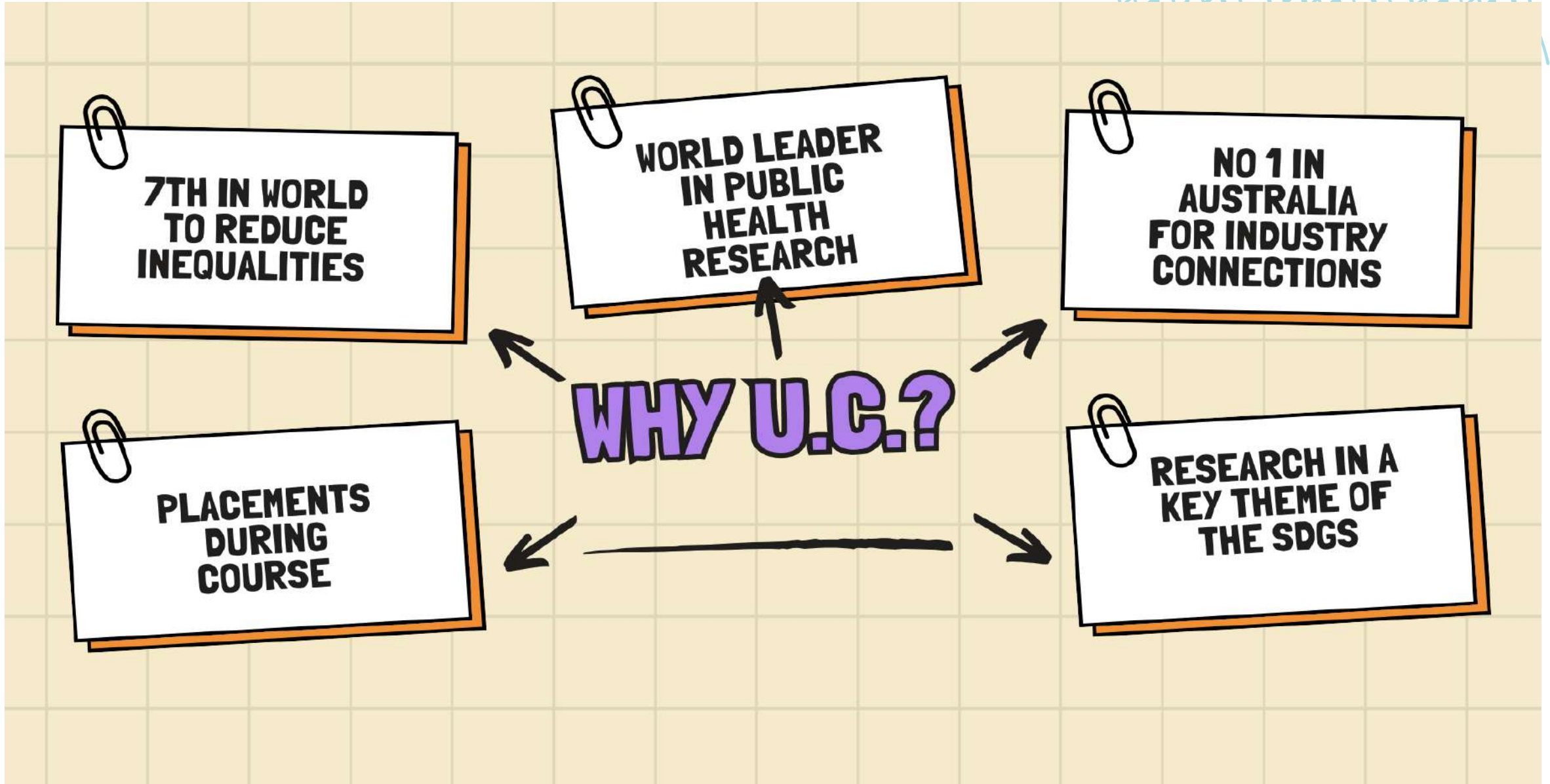

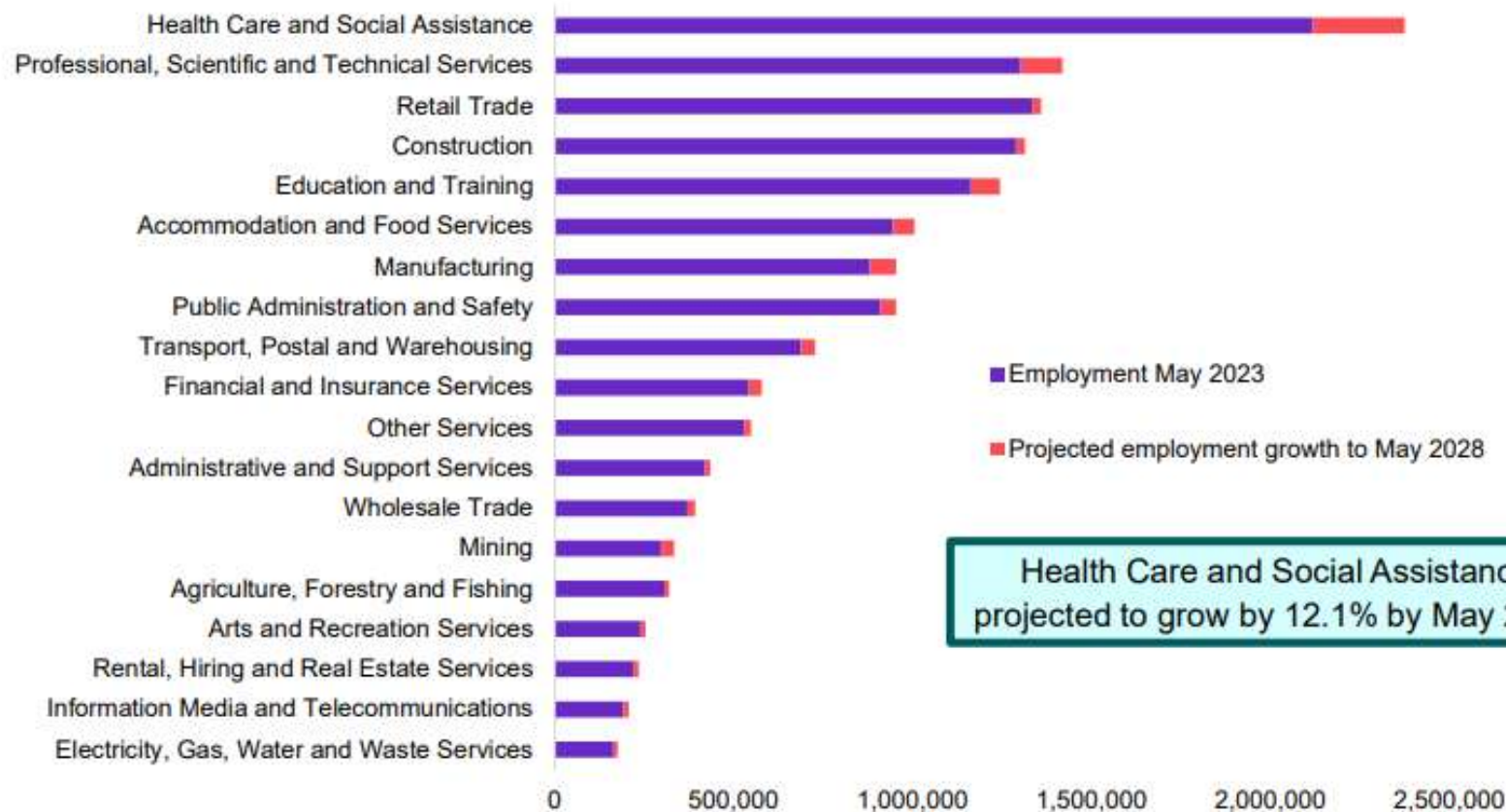

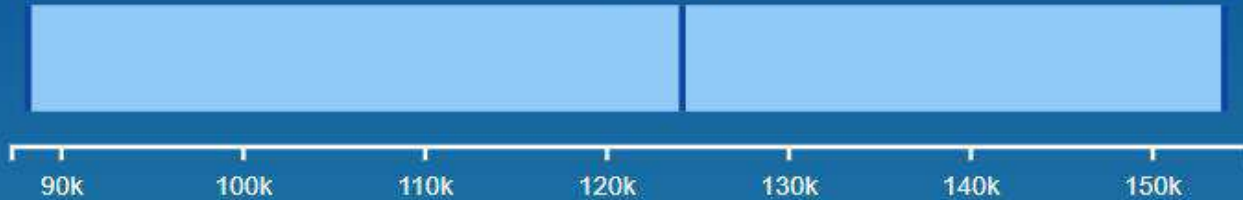

The average registered nurse gross salary in Sydney, Australia is \$124,131 or an equivalent hourly rate of \$60. This is 6% higher (+\$7,531) than the average registered nurse salary in Australia. 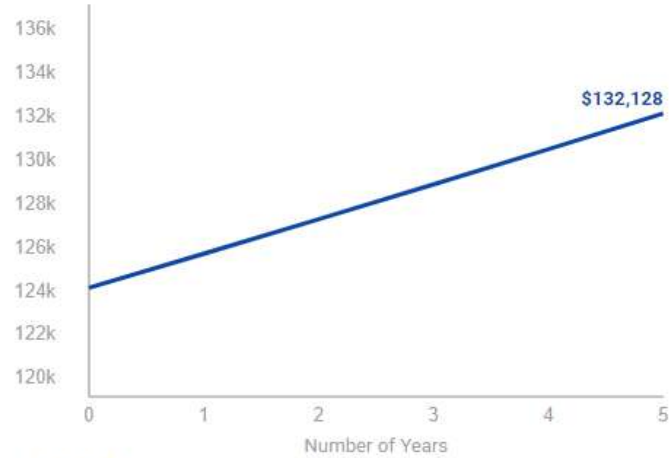

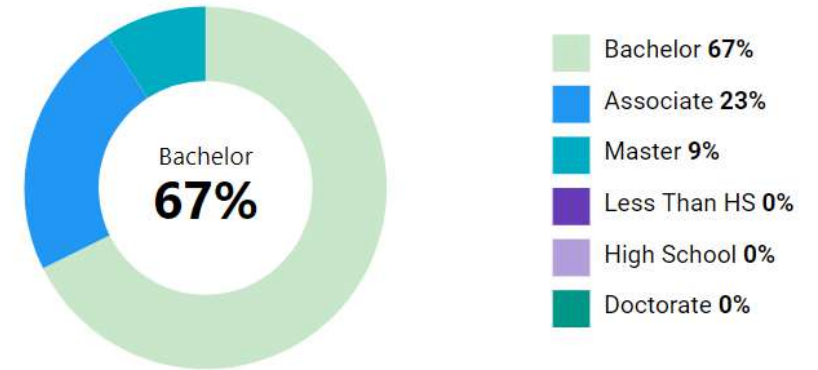

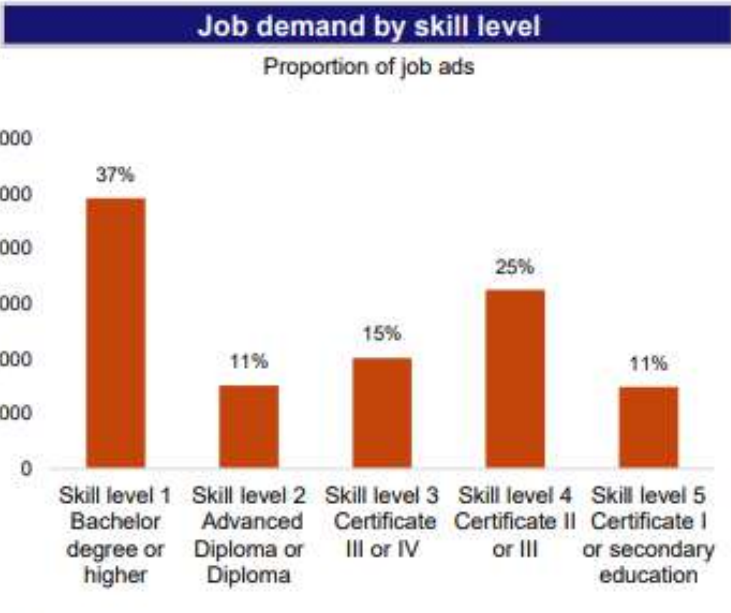
